**PORTALS OF PRAYER** for July-September are available on the Guest Book table in the narthex.

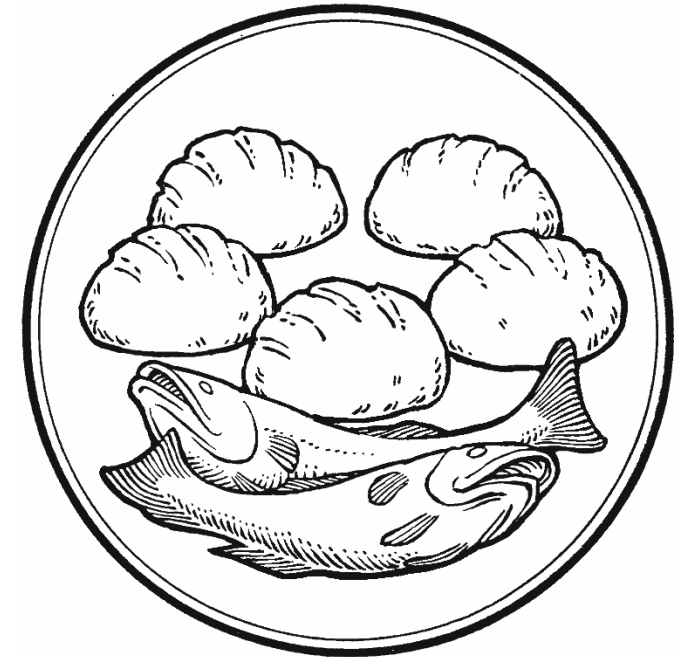
